Complete a Lifestyle Management Program—Complete the program online or by phone between January 1 and December 31, 2010.	Log in to www.myTHR.org and select the Be Healthy link on the left side of the page. Then click on Online Health Coach. OR call 1-877-MyTHRLink (1-877-698-4754) and select option 4, prompt 3 and ask to enroll in a Wellness Coaching Program.	This program helps you evaluate your lifestyle, identify opportunities for improvement, and get support in making changes.	\$50
Complete a Stress Assessment— Complete a Stress Assessment by telephone between January 1 and December 31, 2010.	Call 1-877-MyTHR <i>Link</i> (1-877-698-4754) and select option 4, prompt 4 and ask to complete your Stress Assessment.	A coach can help you identify the things that cause stress and offer options to help manage stress.	\$50
Get a Preventive/Wellness Exam— Get a preventive/wellness exam through your doctor between January 1 and December 31, 2010. You must be enrolled in the Total Health Medical Plan to participate in this element. Complete an Online Back Health Assessment—Complete a Back Health Assessment online between January 1 and December 31, 2010.	Log in to www.myTHR.org and select Be Healthy link. Then select Healthy Back from the Helpful Links dropdown box in the upper-right corner. Since the Healthy Back program is administered by a separate vendor, you will need to register to complete the assessment.	The assessment helps you identify risks to your back and learn how to care for your back.	\$25

Cancer Screenings

Colorectal cancer—colonoscopy This type of cancer can be very successfully treated when detected early. It involves cancer cells that grow in the colon, rectum, or both.
